In order to help you manage your information sources and notes for your Renaissance Research, we are going to use a website called NoodleTools. It will help you create your Works Cited list and your notecards. You can use NoodleTools in school or at home or on any computer with Internet access. Before you can use NoodleTools, you must register. **Please complete the following steps by Wednesday, May 27** by using the Internet after school or at home. If you do not have Internet access at home, you can get Internet access at the public library. Make sure to bring your library card with you! **If you have already used NoodleTools, see the back of this sheet.**

NoodleTools Registration

1. Go to tjlibrary.org and click on **DATABASES, ENCYCLOPEDIAS and NOODLETOOLS**
2. Click on **NoodleTools**. You may need to enter a special **User Name and Password** to open **NoodleTools** from outside of school. Enter **07410** as the **special User Name** and **thomasjefferson** as the **special Password**. **In school, you can click on NoodleTools under Favorites in Internet Explorer.**
3. Click **Create A Personal ID**. If you are asked for a password, use **thomasjefferson**
4. Select **2013** as your **Expected Year of Graduation**
5. Under **Choose A Personal ID**: use your **school network user name** and **password** for your **Personal ID** and **Password** and **Retype your password**
6. Under Easy Login Retrieval: **Initials**: type your initials and **Phone**: type the last 4 digits of your phone number
7. Click **Register**
8. Click 
9. Under **List style**: select **MLA Starter**
10. Next to **Description**: type the following, **using your teacher's name** and **class period**
